Junior Bitch (7,2)

1st Stock's - Shemist Dark Angel, tri with a full white collar which shows off her reach of neck, dark eyes, well placed ears and used to good advantage, lovely shape, good angulation, going through the junior stage with

coat and moved well. 2nd Esterbon Three Kisses for Tighness, tri similiar to 1 very nice shape another one that needs a little more coat and just a little unsettled on the move. 3rd Sanscott Shimmer at Jontygray

Novice Bitch (6)

1st Hateley's - Viewdale Anna, a lovely happy tri, correct wedge shaped head, and good eye placement, well placed ears which she used to her advantage, nice shape and well balanced, good angulation with nothing to hide as showed in her movement, just needs her coat to complete the picture. 2nd Roberts' – Malaroc Rainfall, 3rd Atkins' – Sanscott Shimmer At Jontygray.

Graduate Bitch (10,3)
